





Santa Clara County Housing Authority

The information was used to develop 18 Business Continuity Plans (BCP) for functional teams within the agency. The BCPs establish procedures to continue and/or recover the critical business processes in the event of a business disruption. Each BCP identifies the activities, resources, and procedures needed to carry out the critical business processes.


